Art on Paper is unveiling its programme in the run-up to its 9th edition, to be held in Brussels from 03 to 06 October.

To mark the occasion, the Gare Maritime will be transformed into a 'Grand-Palais du dessin' and Art on Paper will be promoting drawing and works on paper through the 5th edition of the Brussels Drawing Week. The event will feature a packed programme of events for art lovers and drawing collectors from all over Europe.

A 9th edition contemporary, modern and ... ancient!

Here we go again: the Gare Maritime is getting ready for its annual transformation into the 'Grand Palais of Drawing' as part of the Art on Paper fair, welcoming almost 50 Belgian and international galleries this year.

The fair offers an exceptional scene of drawing through the centuries. Once again this year, it confirms the value of its unique concept, with almost 10 modern and antique art galleries (A&R Fleury - Paris), Thomas Deprez Fine Arts - Brussels) and Galerie de la Béraudière - Brussels, Geneva).

On the international front, the Almine Rech gallery, established in 8 countries around the world, 3 Asian galleries (2 Korean and 1 Japanese) and an American gallery (Keijsers Koning - USA) are among the exhibitors.

We should also mention the presence of a great number of artists at the opening of the fair, and the high profile given to Asian artists by the galleries Yeemock (Seoul), Ingahee (Seoul), Lee Bauwens (Brussels) and Sept (Brussels).

'Thanks to its human-scale format, its remarkable, eco-responsible location in Brussels (Gare Maritime), its artistic quality and its unique positioning, Art on Paper stands out among international initiatives,' explains Gilles Parmentier, Director of Art on Paper. For him, 'it's an important event in the Belgian fair calendar, offering a unique opportunity to access exceptional works at affordable prices'.

1º Works op papier - Jos Knaepen Collection (1933-2014)

With the support and implication of the King Baudouin Foundation, a selection of works on paper by collector Jos Knaepen (1933-2014) will be on show in a unique exhibition featuring pieces by Larry Bell, Jean Fautrier, Sam Francis, Henri Michaux, Robert Motherwell, David Nash and others.

This collection - the exhibition marking the first collaboration between Art on Paper and the King Baudouin Foundation - reflects the profile of the majority of visitors to the Fair: real, passionate enthusiasts looking for their favourite works to live and dream with, as Jos Knaepen so aptly put it: 'I'm passionate about colour and the expression of life'.

2° TRÉSORS CACHÉS - The graphic art collection of Henri Van Cutsem (1839-1904)

In collaboration with the Musée des Beaux-Arts de Tournai, a selection of drawings by Brussels patron and collector Henri Van Cutsem (1839-1904) will give visitors the opportunity to rediscover a unique and exceptional collection at the Museum.

The only museum ever designed as such by the architect Victor Horta, the Musée des Beaux-Arts de Tournai is recognised as one of Wallonia's outstanding heritage sites. With works by renowned artists such as Ensor, Fantin-Latour, Manet, Monet, Seurat, Van Gogh, Toulouse-Lautrec and Van der Weyden, its collection is considered one of the most important in Belgium.

A conference not to be missed: « Museums and Works on Paper »

Art on Paper and the Royal Museums of Fine Arts of Belgium are joining forces to organise a conference on the theme of 'Museums and Works on Paper', on Friday 04.10.2024 from 10am to 12am (Royal Museums of Fine Arts of Belgium, 3 rue de la Régence, 1000 Brussels).

Curators from Belgian and international institutions will come together to discuss the issues they share in relation to the paper medium, whose fragility implies well-defined display rules. They will discuss their acquisition policies, with purchases and donations/legacies from private collections creating a body of work that is often very dense. Conversations will also focus on each institution's own digitisation policies, which make it possible to share these often invisible works with as many people as possible.

Art on Paper - international drawing fair

Founded by Michel Culot and Pierre Hallet (1953 - 2021), Art on Paper quickly evolved from a pop-up store into an art fair dedicated to the practice of drawing at BOZAR with the support of Paul Dujardin (from 2014) and Sophie Lauwers. Today, Art on Paper presents a unique panorama of the quality and diversity of approaches to contemporary, modern and antique drawing through the organisation of a benchmark international fair in Brussels. Since 2018, the fair has been run by Gilles Parmentier (Fair Director), who in 2019 initiated the Brussels Drawing Week, bringing together those involved in drawing and works on paper in Brussels. The fair now benefits from the expertise of Virginie Devillez (Senior Fair Advisor) and the commitment of the members of the fair's Advisory Board. The fair is

organised by the non-profit organisation Bruxelles s'anime in collaboration with Studio Gondo, and the support of VO Group.
