A New Vision for Art Fairs

Wishing to offer a playful alternative to traditional fairs, inspired by similar successful experiences in New York (Gramercy), Brussels (White Hotel), and Bangkok (Hotel Art Fair), art dealer **Patrick Mestdagh** has teamed up with gallery owner **Sébastien Janssen** (*Sorry We're Closed*) to organise a brand-new Brussels art and antiques fair.

Simply called **The Rooms**, this unique fair will take over several dozen rooms at **The Mix Brussels**, a 4-star hotel and club inaugurated in spring 2023 in the former headquarters of Royale Belge in Watermael-Boitsfort.

In total, more than **thirty contemporary art galleries and Belgian and international art and antiques dealers** will share the space, occupying an entire wing of the building. The goal is to **preserve the welcoming and original character** of the rooms they take over, offering a **more intimate experience** for visitors to engage with the exhibited artworks.

The event, open to all audiences, will also feature **an exhibition of monumental sculptures, a series of conferences, and a special room curated by designer Lionel Jadot** (*Zaventem Ateliers*). Jadot, who designed the interior of The Mix, will be invited to assemble and showcase objects selected from the participating galleries.
