Dedicated to fun in the sun and on the beach, the Vilebrequin and Ines de La Fressange Paris capsule collection bolsters the reputation of **traditional know-how** on the international scene.

Sporting the colours of the French flag, this collection sails between blue, white and red, and highlights the symbols and emblems of Paris all the way to the shores of the Côte d'Azur.
